

STC Raffle Official Rules & Regulations

1. The grand prize in this Sacramento Theatre Company (STC) Raffle (the "Raffle") shall be a trip for two to Italy, commonly marketed by Sports Leisure Vacations as "A Grand Tour of Italy" (Prize) scheduled for September 14-24, 2014. Buyers are advised that in order to take this trip they must meet the following requirements. 1) Travelers must have a passport that will be valid through March of 2015. 2) Travelers must be physically capable of walking three city blocks. 3) Travelers with extreme dietary limitations may not be accommodated. In the event that the traveler(s) have questions about these requirements, they may contact Sports Leisure Vacations directly at 916-361-2051. Winners not meeting these requirements will be offered "Thanksgiving In New York" as an alternative, as this trip is much more amenable to people who require special accommodations.

2. Winner is responsible for all taxes associated with receipt of the prize. Per IRS Regulations the prize will be treated and classified as a noncash payment. A noncash payment must be taken into account at its fair market value (FMV) for purposes of reporting and withholding. Because the FMV of The Prize exceeds \$5,000, after deducting the price of the wager, the winnings are subject to 25% regular gambling withholding. The winner shall pay the withholding tax to the payer (STC), and STC shall remit the amount to the United States Treasurer and issue a W-2 G reporting the value of the vacation and the amount of tax withheld. Prior to booking the trip, the winners will supply STC with a social security number and driver's license number, or other approved secondary form of identification as required by the IRS via form W-9 and full payment of the 25% of the gambling withholding required by the IRS.

3. Alternate Prize – If the Winner has not complied with IRS Regulations regarding receipt of the prize within 30 days of notification (June 18, 2014) an alternate cash prize will be awarded, in the amount of \$4,900.

3. The price per chance, as evidenced by a Raffle ticket (each, a "Ticket") is \$10.00, made payable by check to "Sacramento Theatre Company" or "STC" and mailed to:

4. BY ENTERING THIS RAFFLE, ENTRANTS ACCEPT AND AGREE (1) TO BE BOUND BY ALL THE RULES, LIMITATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS SET FORTH HEREIN AND (2) THAT THEIR NAMES AND/OR LIKENESSES MAY BE DISCLOSED TO AND USED BY THE NEWS MEDIA AND MAY OTHERWISE BE USED BY STC FOR PUBLICITY PURPOSES AND MAY BE PUBLISHED IN REGIONAL NEWSPAPERS AND ANNOUNCED ON THE STC RAFFLE WEBSITE. OTHER RULES AND REGULATIONS MAY APPLY. PLEASE CONTACT STC IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS. STC'S INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE FINAL.

5. Tickets will be distributed and Ticket stubs will be collected in the order that purchase price is received. Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Checks that are returned for insufficient funds or other reasons will disqualify the Ticket.

6. All entries must be received by 5 p.m. (PST) on May 18, 2014, to be eligible for the drawing. The Raffle drawing will be held at 1:00 p.m. (PST) on May 19, 2014 at 1419 H Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.

7. A Maximum of 5,000 tickets will be sold.

8. Winner(s) must claim and accept ownership of the prize(s) and complete all necessary tax related paperwork to achieve compliance with IRS Regulations within 2 weeks from date of drawing or forfeit the prize and a new winner will be selected.

9. The \$10.00 Ticket price is not deductible for income tax purposes as a charitable deduction. The IRS states that amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.

11. Winner need not be present to win.

12. Winner will be notified by phone.

13. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations, and is void wherever prohibited or restricted by law.

14. Each numbered Raffle Ticket stub will be placed in the Raffle Ticket container. The Sacramento Theatre Company shall appoint a single individual eighteen years of age or older who will be responsible for maintaining control and security of all of the Raffle Ticket stubs. Such individual shall, by public certification under oath at the time of the drawing, certify that all Raffle Tickets purchased have their corresponding stub in the container of stubs where the winning Raffle Ticket will be drawn. Winner will be determined by random drawing.

15. Participants must be 18 or older to enter the raffle and be eligible for the prize.

16. Only one (1) person may be identified as the purchaser of a Ticket. Title to the prizes shall be in the name on the Raffle Ticket stub. Tickets are not transferable or assignable. Prizes are also not transferable or assignable.

17. Employees of the Sacramento Theatre Company, its officers, directors, and immediate members of their families living in the same household are not eligible to win.

18. Proceeds of the Raffle are solely for the benefit of the Sacramento Theatre Company, which is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization registered with the Secretary of State of California.

20. Ticket purchasers, by participating (and winners, by accepting a prize) release the Sacramento Theatre Company, and its respective Board, committee members, volunteers, partners, vendors, agents, representatives, sponsors, service agencies and independent contractors, and each of their respective directors, officers partners, employees and agents, including advertising, public relations, direct marketing and promotion agencies, from any and

all liability with respect to participation in the promotion and possession or use of the prize(s) awarded. Any liability of the Sacramento Theatre Company shall be limited to Ticket price paid and in the case of any dispute, the decision of the Sacramento Theatre Company shall be final.
