**Description:**

The lead carpenter is part of our scenic department and is responsible for the construction, installation, and strike of scenery for each production. Applicants should have experience with wood and metal scenery construction, an understanding of the theatre production process, as well as a commitment to safety and awareness.

**Responsibilities:**

- Build scenery and scenic pieces for our productions from construction drawings
- Assist transporting and installing scenery in our theatre spaces
- Assist in striking scenery at the end of each production
- Work on special projects and effects for productions or department use as needed
- Help to maintain theatre spaces and scene shop
- Other duties as necessary

**Qualifications:**

- Knowledge of scenery construction methods and standard practices
- Carpentry skills with wood and basic metal working
- Experience with power tools, woodworking, and metalworking equipment
- Attention to detail and commitment to quality
- Ability to read and understand technical design drawings
- Ability to work independently and with others
- Follow safety procedures -PPE, safe lifting, etc.
- Valid driver's license
- Ability to lift 50 lbs.
