DIRECTOR'S NOTE

... Use your thoughts to hoist the sails and deck the ships awaiting us this early, gray. and misty dawn in 1885. It's those moments that not only warm my heart as an educator, but are the reason I do what I do. The students in this production have put in many hours of work, and I'm so immensely proud to have been there to witness it.

Both Neverland and Wasp Cast, Thank you for trusting me with guidance and not only creating an environment the inspired me to be a better director but inspired one another to excel. Your love, support, and trust of one another was nothing less than inspiring to be a part of. I would like to express my gratitude to the Families of both casts.
